Kancheepuram, July 27:

Tamil Nadu Governor Banwarilal Purohit called for measures to take forward the visionary projects of Kanchi Shankaracharya Sri Jayendra Saraswathi, aimed at uplifting India and Indian culture, as a homage to the seer's contribution to society.

Governor Banwarilal Purohit participated in the 87th Jayanthi Celebration of Jayendra Saraswathi Sankaracharya Swamigal at Manimandabam.

Governor handed over a cheque for Rs. 1 crore from Governor's discretionary fund to Shri Shankara Kripa Educational and Medical Trust towards establishment of Cath Lab in Kancheepuram.

His holiness Vijayendra Saraswathi Swamigal was present.

Describing the Acharya as "an epitome of modesty and simplicity," the governor said his calmness and silence attracted millions to him.

Stalin directs issuing order to implement 10.5% special reservation for vanniars

Chennai, July 27:

Chief Minister M.K. Stalin announced that he directed officials to issue the government order to implement 10.5% special reservation for vanniars in admission to all courses, including professional courses, from 2021-22.

An official release of the government said, "After consultation with legal experts and the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission (TNPS), chief minister M K Stalin issued an order to implement the 10.5% special reservation from February 26, 2021.

The release said, The government to implement an Act that provides 10.5% special reservation for the Vanniars in education and employment with retrospective effect from February 26 this year. The AIADMK government passed the Act in February.

The special reservation within the MBC quota would be applicable for admission to all educational programmes, including professional programmes, from this year.

"The government further directs that the roster prescribed in this order shall be given effect from February 26, 2021, and it shall be made applicable in respect of those vacancies notified by the recruiting agencies and the appointing authorities on or after the said date," the government order said. It said necessary amendments to the Tamil Nadu Government Servants



(Conditions of Service) Act, 2016, would be issued separately.

This was after the PMK pointed out the vanniya quota was not mentioned in the information brochures and applications for engineering and arts and science admissions released on Monday.

When the assembly was in session, the CM had told PMK leader G K Mani that a good decision will be made on implementing the quota after consultation with legal experts and officials on changing the roster system.

The previous AIADMK government had passed the legislation to temporarily provide for 10.5% special reservation for vanniars within the 20% quota for most backward classes (MBCs).

After the Supreme Court refused

to stay the legislation in the first week of July, it was expected that the 10.5% special quota would be implemented from this academic year.

However, the admission brochures and applications to engineering, arts and science courses did not mention it reservation. In a statement on Monday, PMK leader S Ramadoss asked the state government to withdraw the notifications and issue the fresh notifications including the special quota for vanniars.

Later in the day, the state government issued the order, which will see at least 14,000 BE, BTech seats and 10,000 seats in 143 government arts and science colleges reserved for vanniars. Of 20% seats allocated to MBCs in the existing MBBS seat matrix, nearly 500 seats will be reserved for vanniars.

PMK spokesperson K Balu said the government's announcement will help uplift vanniars socially and educationally as more students from the community will now enter professional colleges. "It is an important day in the journey of social justice.

The special reservation is the result of a 40-year-long struggle by our leader Ramadoss. We thank former CM Edappadi K Palaniswami, former law minister C Ve Shanmugam and chief minister M K Stalin," he said.

Give respect to leaders while publishing news articles, says Madras High Court

Chennai, July 27:

The Madras High Court has directed the Tamil daily 'Dinamalar' to refrain from publishing news articles in a disrespectful manner.

The court censured the daily for addressing former Chief Minister J

Jayalalitha as 'J' in an article.

The court passed the order on July 12 while hearing the plea filed by the editor (since deceased) and publisher of the Tamil newspaper seeking the quashing of proceedings initiated by them for an offence punishable under Section 500, 501 of IPC.

The single-member bench of Justice V Bhavani Subbarayan observed, "She should have been addressed as Hon'ble Chief Minister J Jayalalitha and not as 'J'. While printing and publishing matters with regard to leaders of the

country or state, the petitioners are supposed to give respect and address them accordingly."

During the hearing, the state argued that the defamatory allegations were with respect to the act or conduct of the then Chief Minister in the discharge of her public functions.

The petitioners also argued that Section 199(2) of the Cr.P.C. provides a special procedure with regard to the initiation of proceedings for prosecution for defamation of a public servant.

However, the petitioners argued that this does not constitute defamatory allegations with respect

to the act or conduct of the then Chief Minister in the discharge of her public functions and at best can only be treated as personal defamation.

"If the defamatory statement is personal in nature, this special procedure will not apply and it is only the concerned person who has to file the complaint in his or her individual capacity," stressed the court.

The court said that allegations on which the criminal complaint was filed do not in any way touch upon the conduct of the aggrieved person in discharge of her public function.
